



Tournament of Champions Players Code of Conduct



It is a privilege to be part of the Tournament of Champions. Everyone who participates must refrain from “conduct detrimental to the integrity the game and the TOC as a whole. This includes Tournament Host, Coaches/Players, Family Members or Coaches/Players and anyone who is there supporting the event in any way.

Conduct by anyone in the Tournament that is illegal, violent, dangerous, or irresponsible and puts innocent victims at risk, damages the reputation of Tournaments or the integrity of the game is not tolerated.

We must always demonstrate that we are people of high character; we must show respect for others and we must strive to conduct ourselves in ways that favorably reflect on ourselves, our league mates and the TOC Tournaments as a whole.

This Personal Conduct Policy is enforced by the TOC Board and TOCRC Committee Members, applies to the everyone that participates or are there to support any member or the tournament.

All administrative members of the TOC are encouraged to communicate this policy to everyone that is participating in a TOC event.

1. Respect the participants, participant’s family members, facilities workers and followers/fans that attend any TOC event.
2. You should always demonstrate great sportsmanship towards your opponent.
3. Know your surrounding and please refrain from the usage of profanity at all times,
 4. Respect the individual that is assigned to officiate your game. They don’t get paid and they are doing the best they can.
5. Cheating of any sort is prohibited. If caught cheating you will automatically forfeit your game and depending on the severity of the infraction you can be banned for the remainder of tournament play and possibly indefinitely. This can include for the remainder of a tournament year or a lifetime ban.
6. Possession of a weapon is prohibited at all times unless you’re a member of some type of law enforcement. Weapons include anything that can harm a person and they are not needed at any TOC event. If noticed you will be asked to be removed by officials of the local law enforcement.
7. By signing this agreement it indicates that you have read and understand the TOC rule book and you are going to adhere to the stipulations in both documents. Failure to comply can result in a disciplinary action that’s could include immediate suspension of play in the current tournament, suspension of play in tournament for the calendar season and/or suspension of play in a tournament indefinitely until you are approved by the TOC and the TOCRC Committees
8. Any threatening of physical harm will not be tolerated and is a cause for immediate removal from the tournament and you will not be reinstated until a formal inquiry has been concluded and you informed of the results from a vote.

If a participant in a TOC Tournament violates any of these terms and conditions created by the TOC Board and TOCRC Committee, they will be subjected to disciplinary action enforced by the TOC Disciplinary Committee. Conversely, the participant in violation will have the right to file an appeal to have any disciplinary action terminated or reevaluated for future tournament participation.
